Paul works primarily in Resin Oils on canvas, and in small scale sculpture in an attempt to explain what it is like to live as a European migrant in the South Pacific, especially Aotearoa, and what makes a particular landscape, object, or concept significant to that experience. He has a strong interest in the use of pigments and pattern and their ability to facilitate storytelling through accidental or intended transference into human experience.
